### Literacy and English



**Reading:** In class, pupils will be reading *Turtle Moon* by Hannah Gold. Our focus will be on learning reading skills such as Fluency, Vocabulary and Comprehension skills. We will continue to revisit and learn new phonemes to enhance our phonics knowledge, allowing us to decode and encode with confidence.

**Writing:** We will focus on Explanation and Procedural.


**Listening and Talking:** Pupils will be sharing their thoughts and ideas during guided reading, answering literal and inferential questions about texts.

### R.E:



Our focus this term will be on Easter, and we will also learn about Humanism. We will learn to show understanding of the terms- parable, gospel and miracle through discussion of selected stories.

### Numeracy and Mathematics



**Patterns & Relationships I-13a/b** – We will be learning to describe, continue and make more complex patterns, involving shapes, pictures, movements, number and symbols, using a variety of variables including patterns within multiplication tables.

**Data & Analysis I-20ab/21a**– We will be learning to select and use appropriate ways to collect, organise, display and interpret information for a given purpose using bar graphs, tables, diagrams and charts.

**Multiplication & Division I-03a**– We will multiply and divide mentally by 2, 4 and 8, showing rapid recall, to questions phrased in a variety of ways e.g. six twos, 3 times and Carry out practical tasks using concrete materials to reinforce understanding of able facts for the 3, 6 and 9 times tables. Recite the facts of the 3, 6 and 9 times tables with increasing accuracy.

**Fractions MNU I-07abc:** We will learn about, use and compare fractions.

**Measure MNU I-11a:** We will explore measure, length, weight and volume through practical and written investigations.

### Class Study (IDL/Topic)



#### Farming

Through the context of Farming, we will be exploring:

- land use and farming in Scotland.
- Farming technology.
- Food journeys
- Environmental issues.

#### Independent Topic

Primary 4 will have a very exciting opportunity to choose their own IDL Context towards the end of the school year. We look forward to finding out what will be chosen! Pupils will work in groups to research, resource and finally teach their own topic.

## STEM (including Digital Technology) Contexts and links to Creativity:



Pupils will be visiting the ICT suite to learn how to use emails respectfully and responsibly. We will learn to compose an email that is sent on behalf of my group or class. We will develop our skills of touch typing, in using and saving PowerPoint and Publisher. We will explore and experiment with tabs and with simple keyboard shortcuts – e.g. ctrl s, ctrl c, v, b, l, u. In class, we will also continue to have regular opportunities to enhance our learning using iPads.

We will cover lots of science through our Farming topic, including learning about technology used in agriculture. We will also learn about sustainability through our IDL focus.

## Art and Design Contexts and Skills:

We will be learning about textile and product design through art projects linked to our IDL topic and Enterprise.

## Music and Drama Contexts and Skills:

We are delighted our children can participate in the School Show.

Already we have had many children showing interest in being a part of the ensemble and have some eager backstage helpers.

We will also be hosting 'Play in a Day' from Konflux Theatre Company. This is an exciting opportunity for p4 pupils – more information to follow.
