Literacy and English

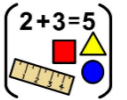


Reading: In class, pupils will be reading a class novel; The Wild Robot by Peter Brown. Our focus will be on learning reading skills such as summarising, visualising, metalinguistics, inference and prior knowledge. We will continue to revisit and learn new phonemes to enhance our phonics knowledge, allowing us to decode and encode with confidence.

Writing: We will focus on Character, **Setting** and Recount

Listening and Talking: Pupils will be sharing their thoughts and ideas during guided reading, answering literal and inferential questions about texts.

Numeracy and Mathematics



Place Value – We will be learning to read, write, partition, order and compare numbers up to 1000 or beyond.

Shape – We will be recognising 2D and 3D shapes, classifying and comparing shapes using mathematical language such as sides, corners and edges.

Number – We will focus on our 3x and 4x tables through daily CLIC sessions. We will also learn some new strategies to help us with addition and subtraction.

Health and Well-Being and PE



Health and Wellbeing: We will begin Primary 4 by learning about the UN Rights of the Child – using this to create our class charter.

PE: PE days are

P4 – Monday & Friday.

P5/4 – Tuesday & Friday

We have 10 weeks of Swimming lessons every Monday.

Thereafter we will focus on Team Games, Basketball, Gymnastics & Rugby.

Class Study (IDL/Topic)



P4's in Mrs King's class will be learning about the Egyptians this term. They will explore who the Egyptians were, how they lived, and why they are still remembered today

P4's in Miss Glass's class will be learning about Flight this term. They will investigate how things fly, the forces involved in flight, and the history of human attempts to take to the skies.

Art and Design Contexts and Skills:

We will be learning about line, shape and colour through art projects linked to our IDL topic.



R.E:

We will be learning about Christianity and World Religions – focussing on their beliefs and roles in Scotland.



STEM (including Digital Technology) Contexts

and links to Creativity: Pupils will be visiting the ICT suite to learn touch typing, PowerPoint and Internet Safety. In class, we will also have regular opportunities to enhance our learning using iPads.

We will cover lots of science through our Ancient Egyptian topic. Through our IDL topic we will also explore sustainability, looking at responsible use of water dependence on natural resources, climate and environment.



Music and Drama Contexts and Skills:

We will be learning songs for our MacMillan Coffee Morning– getting ourselves performance-ready! MacMillan Coffee Morning will be on Friday 25th September 2026– time details to follow.

P4/5 also have weekly music lessons in our new music room with Mrs Holmes this term.



Modern Languages Topics:

We will be exploring Spanish vocabulary with the pupils covering the topics: Greetings, Days of the Week, Months of the Year, I like/Don't like, Colours, Fruit & Vegetables, Weather and Classroom/Schoolbag items.
