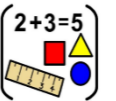
Numeracy and Mathematics

Flight

This term, we will explore the exciting world of flight. We will learn about the history of flight and the achievements of various pilots, inventors, and engineers. We will investigate the technology used in aircraft and discover how planes stay in the air by studying the four forces of flight: lift, weight, thrust, and drag. Through research and practical activities, we will develop our skills in gathering information, presenting findings, and solving problems while discovering how humans achieved the dream of flying.

Art and Design Contexts and Skills:



Within Expressive Arts, pupils will focus on developing their understanding of line, tone and colour, applying these artistic elements to create a range of observational and imaginative drawings.

Music and Drama Contexts and Skills:

Mrs Holmes delivers a weekly music session in which pupils are currently developing their understanding of basic rhythms using tuned percussion instruments. Pupils are enjoying the opportunity to explore music in a practical and creative way!
