- 19% have someone in their household in this group.

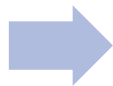
37% of staff have children who'd need cared for when they return to work

Staff had on average 1 child under 5, 3 children age 5-11 and 1 child over 12.

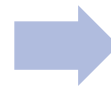

Most respondents (55%) were teachers, 41% were class teachers.

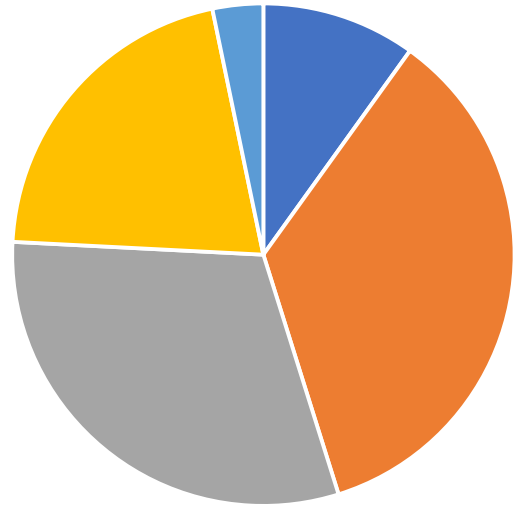


School assistants (15%) and early years practitioners (14%) were the next most common roles.

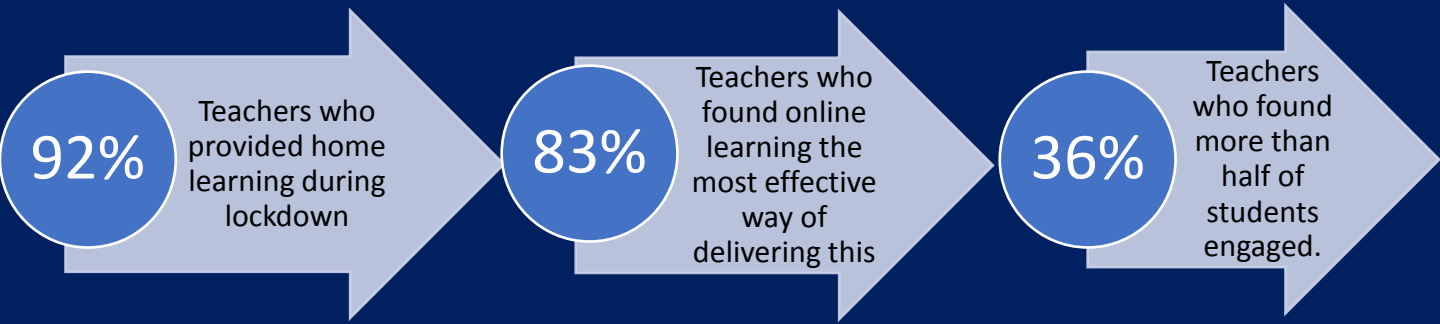


87% of teaching staff said they'd participated in online CLPL.
