Cross-Curricular Theme: The Vikings

Literacy & Language

P1 will continue to learn new sounds, blend and spell simple words. P2, 3 and 4 will continue to learn different spelling/sound patterns using spelling workbooks.

All pupils will continue developing skills across all areas of writing, continuing to explore 'Talk for Writing,' focusing on a variety of writing styles. P1 will develop formation of lower-case letters, P2 upper case letters and P3/4 cursive writing through handwriting activities.

All pupils will continue to develop their reading skills through a range of activities in class and at home.

Health & Wellbeing

Numeracy & Mathematics

Through a range of active activities, P1 will continue to develop their skills in addition and be introduced to subtraction. They will also be exploring time and seasons.

P2 will be continuing to explore numbers to 100 and beyond, addition and subtraction, as well as multiplication.

P3 and P4 will continue to explore multiplication and division.

P2, 3 and 4 will also be time, using 12-hour clocks, 24-hour notation and exploring calendars.

Technologies

This term in technology we are learning how to use digital technology to find, save and use information. We will learn how to log on and stay safe on the computers. We will also use it to create artwork, solve problems and share learning.

This term we will be exploring the properties of different substances and how they can be changed, pupils will develop their understanding of the connection between structure and properties.
