<p>Literacy & Language </p> <p>P2, P3 and P4 will explore different spelling patterns and spelling of tricky words, through active spelling activities, technology and spelling workbooks.</p> <p>All pupils will continue developing their writing skills, focusing on poetry writing, imaginative writing and functional writing.</p> <p>P2 will explore upper case letters and P3/4 cursive writing through handwriting activities. Pupils will be exploring all things sea related... from crabs and coral reefs to shorelines and sharks. Pupils will engage in a range of fun and exciting lessons, across Social Studies, Literacy, Health and Wellbeing, Technologies, Expressive Arts and Science.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Article 24, 27, 28</p> 	<p>Health & Wellbeing </p> <p>The HWB focus this term will be Relationships/Friendships and Random Acts of Kindness, to strength our involvement in the local community.</p> <p>PE - This term pupils will be focussing on developing their skills and techniques in Badminton. Through exploring Christianity, we will also be learning about how different cultures and religions welcome a new baby into the world.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Article 14</p> <p>French</p> <p>Pupils will develop their skills in basic French conversation. <p>Numeracy & Mathematics</p> <p>Through a range of active activities, P2-4 will be developing their skills in addition and subtraction. P3 and P4 will revisit and extend their knowledge and understanding of multiplication and division.</p> <p>Our focus for topical Maths this term will be Data Handling. P2-4 will collect, organise, interpret and display data in a variety of ways. We look forward to collecting, organising and displaying data in a wide range of practical activities.</p>  <p style="text-align: center;">Article 28, 29, 31</p>	<p>Technologies</p> <p>Pupils will continue to explore a range of software on the computers which supports their learning. Including Microsoft Word, Microsoft PowerPoint and the use of ICT to support and enhance their learning across all curricular areas.</p>  <p style="text-align: center;">Article 13, 17, 28</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>The focus for Science this term is Water. Pupils will engage in a variety of hands-on activities to explore states of matter, the water cycle, density and volume and temperatures.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Article 24, 27, 28</p> <p>Music </p> <p>Pupils will continue to engage in Charanga music lessons, focusing on pulse and rhythm. We will be using various techniques to capture the depth and texture of this painting.
