Cross-curricular theme: The Rainforest

<p>Literacy and English</p>  <p>We will continue to develop our comprehension skills using the six comprehension strategies that we are already familiar with. In spelling we will be studying a variety of common and tricky words, subject specific words and spelling rules.</p> <p>Using our Rainforest topic as a stimulus, we will focus on writing narrative and information texts.</p> <p>Article: 28</p>	<p>Social Studies</p>  <p>We will discover and identify the features of rainforests. We will discuss the environmental impact that human activity has on rainforests and also suggest ways in which we can live in a more environmentally-responsible way. After completing our Rainforest topic, we will look at how Victorians celebrated Christmas in the past.</p> <p>Article: 29</p>	<p>Health and Wellbeing</p>  <p>We will have a focus on healthy eating and living a healthy lifestyle. During our PE lessons, we will play team building games, football and improve our stamina. Bikeability Level 2 will commence. The Spirit of Sport programme will be delivered through Active Schools.</p> <p>Article: 19 and 2</p>	<p>Religious and Moral Education</p>  <p>Through our study of Christianity, we will learn about the Creation Story. We will also discover how Christmas was celebrated by the Victorians.</p> <p>Article: 14</p>
<p>Numeracy and Mathematics</p>  <p>We will continue to progress our numeracy skills through daily Big Maths sessions. We will focus on multiplication and division, further explore 2D shapes and 3D objects and look more in depth at angles. We will use our mathematical skills to explore the outdoor environment.</p> <p>Article: 28</p>	<p>Technologies</p>  <p>We will learn what sustainability is and explore ways in which we can live in a more sustainable way. We will discuss the impact lifestyle choices have on our achievement of the 'Global Goals' in Scotland. We will continue to use technology across the curriculum to support learning.</p> <p>Article: 29, 13 and 17</p>	<p>Sciences</p>  <p>Not a focus this term.</p>	<p>Expressive Arts</p>  <p>We will produce a variety of art inspired by the flora and fauna of the rainforest. We will communicate our ideas through drama. Through a range of musical activities, we will express and communicate our ideas, thoughts and feelings.
