Literacy and English

We will continue to develop our comprehension skills using the six comprehension strategies that we are already familiar with. In spelling we will be studying a variety of common and tricky words, subject specific words and spelling rules.

Using our Rainforest topic as a stimulus, we will focus on writing narrative and information texts.
