What are we learning this term?

Cross-curricular theme: Pirates and the Sea

Class: P2/1

<p>Literacy and English P1 will be learning new letters, sounds and tricky code words. We will learn to correctly write each letter. We will start to read simple books and use our books to help us write information. P2 will continue to learn to read and write more advanced words. We will read two reading books a week. Our writing will link to our reading books, news and topic. Article 28</p> 	<p>Social Studies</p> <p>Through play we will learn all about pirates and how they lived in the past. In term two, we will learn about the sea, the creatures that live in it and how we can help the sea by not polluting it. Article: 29</p> 	<p>Health and Wellbeing</p> <p>We will work to recognise the importance of cleanliness, hygiene and safety within everyday routines. We will learn why brushing our teeth is very important to keep us healthy. We will also explore and practise different ways of moving our bodies. Article: 19</p> 	<p>Religious and Moral Education</p> <p>In Term 2, we will learn about the Nativity story and work together to perform this story for the school and parents. Article 14</p> 
<p>Numeracy and Mathematics P1 will work with recognising and ordering numbers to 20. We will investigate number stories to 10 and start to understand the concepts of addition and subtraction using concrete materials. P2 will work with numbers within 100, identify and name 2D shapes and work on estimating the position of numbers on a number line. Article: 28</p> 	<p>Technologies</p> <p>Through discovery and imagination, we will develop and use problem solving strategies to construct models linked to our topic. We will continue to practise logging onto the computer and use simple text-handling features to manipulate text. We will use some computer games to enhance our learning. Articles: 29, 13 and 17</p> 	<p>Sciences</p> <p>We will have fun learning about materials that float and sink. Article: 28</p> 	<p>Expressive Arts</p> <p>During drama activities, we will create, choose and accept roles, using movement, expression and voice. Through our topic, Pirates, we will create work that uses the visual elements of line, shape, colour, pattern and texture. We will be listening to a variety of music, discussing our thoughts and feelings and preparing for our Christmas show. Articles: 29 and 13</p>
