Literacy and **Enalish**

This term we will develop our knowledge of phonics and apply this within all literacy activities. We will continue to build on our comprehension strategies through the reading of new novels. In our writing, we will learn to structure our writing with a clear beginning, middle and end. We will learn to use paragraphs and develop our narrative writing skills.

Social Studies

This term our topic is 'The Titanic.' We will learn about this important event from the past and enjoy bringing the Titanic to life through a range of activities. We will map the journey of the Titanic, find out who was on board and how and why it sank.
