<p>Literacy and English</p>  <p>P1 will learn new sounds and some tricky code words. We will continue to work hard on correct letter formation. We will practise blending our new sounds into words. We will work on becoming increasingly independent when writing. Article 28</p>	<p>Social Studies</p>  <p>Our topic this term will be Pirates. Through play and a variety of activities, we will have fun learning all about how pirates lived in the past. Article: 29</p>	<p>Health and Wellbeing</p>  <p>Our health and wellbeing target this term is to have a healthy body. We will learn about how food, exercise, sleep and play all have an important role in keeping us healthy. We will also learn about dangerous substances such as poisonous berries and medicines. Article: 19 and 2</p>	<p>Religious and Moral Education</p>  <p>We will learn about new beginnings and renewal through our topic, Easter and Spring. Article 14</p>
<p>Numeracy and Mathematics</p>  <p>We will learn how to add coin amounts and how to work out change needed when given a larger amount of money. We will have fun exploring symmetry. We will explore length, weight and volume. In term four, we will learn about fractions and 3D objects. Article: 28</p>	<p>Technologies</p>  <p>We will use some computer games to enhance our learning.</p> <p>We will also use kitchen utensils and equipment to prepare healthy food. Article: 29, 13 and 17</p>	<p>Sciences</p>  <p>In term four, we will learn about plants through our science topic, The Garden Centre. Article 28</p>	<p>Expressive Arts</p>  <p>We will explore different ways of moving and perform some simple dances to Scottish music. During drama activities, we will create, choose and accept roles, using movement, expression and voice. Through our topic, Pirates, we will create work that uses the visual elements of line, shape, colour, pattern and texture. We will enjoy weekly music lessons with Mr. Hill. Articles: 29 and 13</p>
