What are we learning in Primary 6?

Cross-curricular theme(s): The Victorians/Local Council/Scotland

Class: P6 (Terms 3 and 4)

<p>Literacy and English <i>UNCRC Articles 17; 28; 29 & 30</i> <u>Phonics (spelling)</u> We will continue to explore phonemes and their graphemes. As well as this we will be exploring prefixes, suffixes, and the meaning behind the bases of words. <u>Reading</u> We will be continuing to develop our breadth and depth of reading comprehension strategies through a range of fiction and non-fiction texts. <u>Writing</u> We will explore different genres including narrative, persuasive, functional, personal and poetry within a range of contexts. We will have the opportunity to learn and practise writing in line with our topics.</p> 	<p>Social Studies <i>UNCRC Articles 28; 29; 37 & 38</i> We are going to be finding out about 'The Victorians' this term. This will include: * a timeline of the Victorian era; * schools; * rich and poor lives; * homes and living environments; * work and industry; * entertainment and leisure; * inventions. Following our Victorians topic, we will learn about our Local Council and link with the Community Council. Towards the Summer we will explore the history of our Scottish Football team as we support them in the World Cup.</p> 	<p>Health and Wellbeing <u>Healthy Lifestyles</u> <i>UNCRC Articles 6; 12; 16 & 19</i> We will: * develop confidence to face new challenges. * know how to access help & advice to make responsible choices. <u>P.E.</u> <i>Articles 28 & 29</i> P.E. is usually on a Monday and Friday. In term 3 our main focusses are golf and gymnastics. We currently have a 10 week swimming block at Prestwick pool which is on a Thursday. Following this we will be working on badminton skills as well as athletics.</p> 	<p>Religious and Moral Education <i>UNCRC Articles 28 & 30</i> This term, we will be exploring the festival of Holi as part of the Hinduism religion. We will focus on traditions, beliefs, and the meaning behind religious practices as well as comparing our own beliefs to Hinduism traditions. Following this we will be looking at similarities and differences in prayer across Christianity, Sikhism, Islam, Hinduism and Judaism.</p> 
<p>Numeracy and Mathematics <i>UNCRC Articles 28 & 29</i> <u>Numeracy</u> We will focus on using a range of strategies to further our understanding of reading, understanding and solving calculations. <u>Mathematics</u> In our wider Maths we will explore areas such as different triangles, angles within shapes (including using protractors), 3 digit bearings, pie charts and spreadsheets. We will continue to use Big Maths to develop our confidence and accuracy in Maths as well as faster recall of our multiplication tables.</p> 	<p>Technologies <i>UNCRC Articles 13; 17; 28 & 29</i> We are constantly using the iPads and laptops in our class to develop our learning across the curriculum. We will continue to have a focus on Internet Safety, coding and digital presentations. Through our Victorians topic, we will look at the changes in technology over time and explore the benefits of these modifications.</p> 	<p>Sciences <i>UNCRC Articles 28 & 29</i> This term, we will be learning about electricity. Pupils will learn how to design, record and build circuits with a variety of different purposes. They will also explore electrical safety, such as disposing of batteries safely. Following this we will be looking at the 'Human Body'. We will be exploring the functions and roles of the following areas: the Circulatory system; the Digestive system; the Skeletal structure; the Respiratory system; and the Reproductive system with a particular focus on changes in the body.</p> 	<p>Expressive Arts <i>UNCRC Articles 13; 28 & 29</i> <u>Art & Design</u> We will be exploring work by different artists, using their particular techniques and styles to recreate our own versions of their work. <u>Music</u> We will listen to different types of music and identify how these make us feel. <u>Drama</u> We will take part in drama activities related to our Victorians topic.</p>
