Cross-curricular themes: 'Endangered Animals' then 'Travel Agents'

<p>Literacy and English (UNCRC Articles 13 & 28)</p>  <p>We will continue to develop our phonics skills using strategies to help us read and spell new words. In reading, we will use our knowledge of punctuation and grammar to help us read with more fluency, understanding and expression. We are beginning the session with a block of creative writing. We will be considering how to describe mythical creatures/characters through our word choice and descriptions. P2 will continue to learn to read and write more advanced words. We will do one reading book per week. Our writing will link to reading books, news and our topic.</p>	<p>Social Studies (UNCRC Articles 15, 14, 28 & 29)</p>  <p>Our main topic to begin with this session is Endangered Animals. We have already completed a class consultation and planned our learning which will focus on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Learning about and researching endangered animals * Exploring their habitats * How we can help to protect endangered animals <p>We will be reading 'Red Panda Rescue' as our class novel and will link this story to our topic.</p>	<p>Health and Wellbeing</p>  <p>During Health & Wellbeing time, we will focus on the importance of feeling and being safe in different situations. Further to this we will explore the values of friendships in and out with school. We will also develop our awareness of healthy eating. (UNCRC Articles 15 and 24). We will be working to recognise the importance of safety within everyday routines. (UNCRC Article 19).</p> <p><u>P.E.:</u> In PE, we will be reinforcing teamwork and co-operation skills through a variety of possession games. We will also be working to develop skills in badminton and golf. (UNCRC Article 15).</p>	<p>Religious and Moral Education (UNCRC Article 14)</p>  <p>This term we are learning about the Muslim Festival Eid al Fitr, We will discover that Eid is a special holiday which Muslim people celebrate after a time of learning patience and being thankful. We will compare similarities and differences between Eid and more familiar celebration e.g. birthdays.</p> <p>In Term 4, we will explore Religious Artefacts from the World's main religions.</p>
<p>Numeracy and Mathematics (UNCRC Article 28)</p>  <p>We will be developing our skills in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Patterns and Relationships - exploring odd/even numbers * Time * Number - Multiplication and Division * Fractions, Decimals and Percentages <p>We will continue to develop our mental maths strategies through Number Talks, Big Maths, whiteboard games, tabletop games and other activities.</p>	<p>Technologies</p>  <p>During our ICT lessons, we will learn to log on and off independently using our own usernames and passwords. We will be discussing the importance of never sharing passwords for security. We will become more aware of the keyboard and using caps lock, space bar, the enter key etc. Through our topics, we will begin to use the Internet to search for information.</p>	<p>Sciences</p>  <p>We will be exploring topical science links through learning about Endangered Animals. We will be exploring different animals, plants in our local environment. We will be finding out about habitats in our local area. We will develop an understanding of how we can protect living things.</p>	<p>Expressive Arts (UNCRC Article 29)</p>  <p><u>Art:</u> We will be using a variety of art techniques to take part in activities related to our topic as well as seasonal changes as we progress through the term.</p> <p><u>Drama:</u> We will develop our role play skills through our topic by acting out some scenes from our class novel.</p>
