NET (National Evangelisation Team) is a group of inspiring young adults who deliver retreats across Scotland, offering young people the chance to reflect on their identity, relationships, values and faith in a lively, interactive setting.

We are proud to say that NET has visited Queen Margaret Academy for over ten years and their retreats continue to be one of the highlights of our school year. Our pupils speak very positively about the experience, often asking for the team to return. The retreats are designed to be engaging, reflective, and deeply relevant to the lives of young people today.

Venue and Travel:

All retreats will take place at St Paul's Parish Church, Ayr, which is a short walk from Queen Margaret Academy. Pupils will walk to and from the venue in groups, accompanied and supervised by school staff at all times.

Other Key Information:


- Uniform: Pupils should attend the retreat in full school uniform
- Lunch: Pupils will follow their usual lunch break. They may:
 - Bring a packed lunch, or
 - Pre-order a school meal in advance, which will be collected before leaving for the retreat
- Supervision: Pupils will be accompanied by staff at all times during the retreat
- Experience: The day will include talks, activities, small group discussions and reflection in a supportive, values-based environment.
