On Thursday 22nd May all pupils will be attending the QMA Athletics Sports Championships at the Riverside Arena, Ayr. Pupils will be given the option whether they would like to participate in the events or spectate. The events are the 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, long jump, triple jump, high jump, javelin and shot put. The buses will leave school at 9am and will return by the end of the day so pupils are able to get their normal bus home.

For the Sports Day pupils who are taking part should come to school in their PE kit and spectators should wear school uniform as normal. All pupils should bring a packed lunch and be prepared for the weather. There will be stalls available for pupils to purchase a snack if they bring money.
