# Our profile...

When choosing your subjects there are 5 key questions you should ask yourself:


1. How do I like to learn?

**Subject: Administration and IT      Level(s): National 5 (also N3 and N4)**

**Course Overview:**  
Administration and IT cuts across all sectors of the economy and offers wide-ranging employment opportunities. This course provides candidates with experience of real-life administration tasks and engaging practical activities relevant to the world of work; with emphasis on the development of transferable life skills and the application of these skills. Candidates following the course become aware of the use of technology within the workplace, as they complete organisational tasks.

**Course content:**

- Administration Theory** – develop an understanding of administration theory in the workplace, including customer service, corporate image and sources of information.
- Word Processing/Publishing** – learn to create a range of documents from certificates to newsletters.
- Spreadsheets** – create tables, charts, calculations and merge data across applications.
- Databases** – learn to use relational databases to enter, sort and extract information.
- Electronic Communication** – e-diary, e-mail and other communication methods.

**Assessment** – split across two formal practical activities, an exam and assignment, with most of the marks coming from the assignment.

**Career pathways:**  
This course opens up a diverse range of options from developing generic IT skills useful in almost all walks of life to working specifically in Administration for a business.

**Subject: Administration and IT      Level(s): Higher**

**Course Overview:**  
The course helps candidates develop advanced administrative skills & digital literacy, enabling them to contribute to the effective functioning of organisations in supervisory administrative positions.

**Course content:**

- Administration Theory** – develop a deeper understanding of administration theory in the workplace, including effective teams, time management and organising events.
- Word Processing/Publishing** – create a range of complex documents using advanced features.
- Spreadsheets** – complex spreadsheets to process, problem solve and present information.
- Presentations** – Work with existing presentations to research and create a final document.
- Databases** – learn to use relational databases to enter, sort and extract information.
- Electronic Communication** – e-diary, e-mail and emerging technologies.

**Assessment** – split across two formal practical activities, an exam and assignment, with most of the marks coming from the assignment.

**Career pathways:**  
This course opens up a diverse range of options from developing generic IT skills useful in almost all walks of life to working specifically in Administration for a business or moving into specialised areas such as medical administrators or legal administrators.

Please consider the senior phase as a 3-year model. Pupils should be aiming to achieve as many qualifications as they can by the end of S6.




# Beyond the classroom...
