SDS are in schools to help young people understand the world of work.

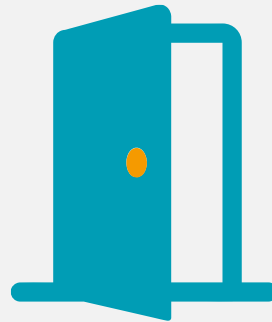
We help them develop and use their career management skills as they move throughout school.

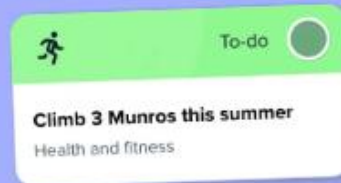

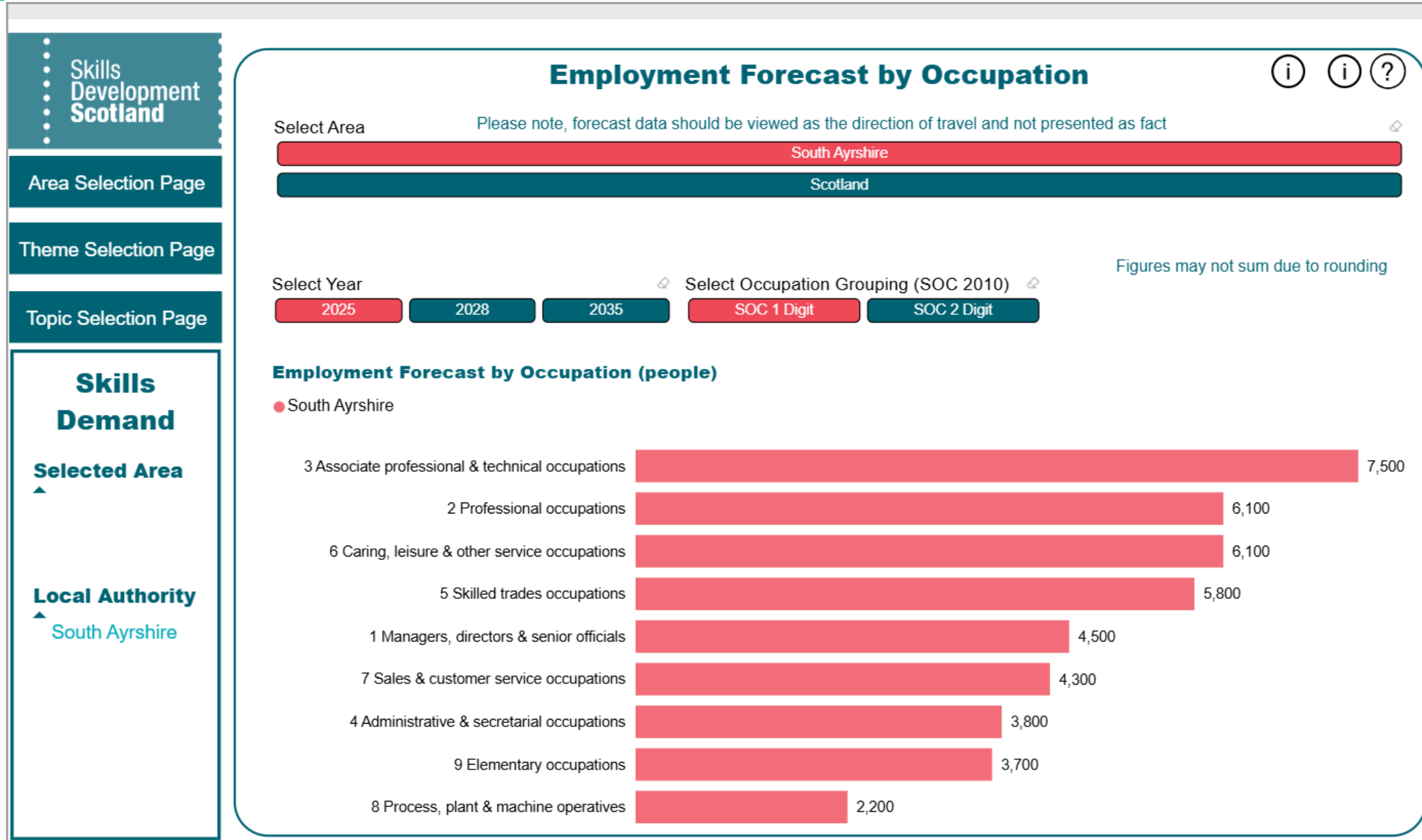

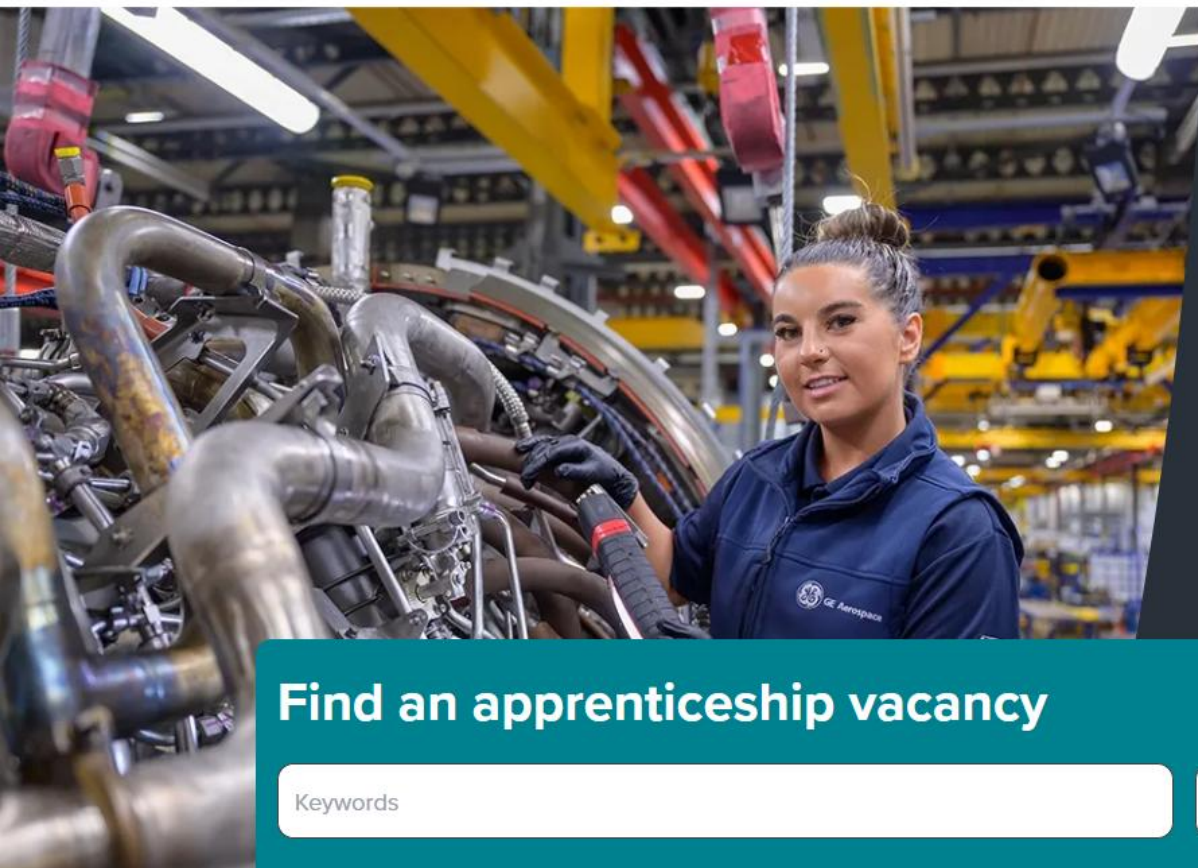
