







We asked - Which platforms do you access to find out about your child's learning?





P7 Registration

Registration for secondary school should now be complete. All families who have registered for Queen Margaret Academy, which is our catchment school, automatically have a place, if you live in South Ayrshire. Results of all placing requests are in April/May. This information will come directly from South Ayrshire.

P1 Registration

P1 registration is also now complete, if you are in our catchment area you will automatically have a place. If you are awaiting the outcome of a placing request this will be confirmed in April directly from South Ayrshire Council. If you have not registered your child for August please contact the school for advice.

P7 Hoodies

As part of our continued commitment to 'no cost to the school day' P7 leavers hoodies have been provided for all of the children from the Parent Council Fundraising. They loved their 'hoodies ceremony' where they all said a small speech about another pupil and wished them luck in their final few months at St. John's.





Staged Intervention Parents' Evening

There are a number of children across the school who receive some additional supports for a variety of reasons and have additional plans called 'Staged Intervention Plans'. The plans highlight the targets that the children are working on. Over the last few years we have added an additional parents' night for the teacher, parent and child to discuss progress and set new targets.

Only children who have a Staged Intervention Plan have this additional appointment and will receive a message from the school to book a suitable time. If parents are struggling with the online booking portal the school will provide an appointment for them. The online booking portal will close at 12pm on Thursday 8^{th} February.

P4-7 Show/concert

Our P4-7 show is back!! The auditions are done and the children have started working on scripts and songs. The performances will be Tuesday 19th and Wednesday 20th March with more details to follow. This year will be 'Music from the Movies' and will involve P4 and P5 as choir with P6 and P7 in the main parts. Parents will be required to book tickets via the school box office from the end of February. There will be no cost to attend the show, however, we will have lucky programmes for sale and a raffle to try and support school funds. Costumes, music etc. can be costly and with a 'No Cost to the School Day' policy we want everyone to be able to enjoy but those who are able can support the school funds on the night with the purchase of raffle tickets. Attendance
