This challenge will be closely linked to the launch of our new House Saints. Pupils and staff will walk between the countries and regions associated with each of our new House Saints, totalling in the region of 28,000 miles and covering 5 continents! During their journeys they will have the opportunity to reflect and pray on the lives of our new House Saints. The miles walked cumulatively will be tracked each week and children will be able to celebrate their progress at departmental assemblies.


