Use of mobile phones Policy 2019

Article 28

You have the right to a good quality education. You should be encouraged to go to school to the highest level you can.

Article 29

Your education should help you use and develop your talents and abilities. It should also help you learn to live peacefully, protect the environment and respect other people.

Article 36

You have the right to protection from any kind of exploitation (being taken advantage of).

Parents/Carers are encouraged to ask their children to leave mobile phones at home.

However, if the pupils do bring mobile phones to school with the approval of their parent/guardian, then the mobile phones are the responsibility of the owner at all times in terms of security and safekeeping.

In St Ninian's Primary those children who have mobile phones should bring their mobile phones to the school office to be stored by Mrs Doherty until the end of the school day.

As a basic premise, mobile phones should be switched off or at silent at all times within the school buildings.
