Here is what P4B-7 at Straiton Primary will be learning about this term.



Reading

Each week we will be spending time working on comprehension strategies through the use of GIGLETS and focusing on the sound we have been working on. We will have daily 'Drop Everything and Read' sessions and we also have our new Reading Challenge with the chance of winning a prize!

Writing

Our Talk for Writing unit is based on the text 'The Dragon Slayer' which will focus on conflict resolution. We will look at what makes a good conflict resolution story and focus on different aspects such as characters feelings, commas to add more information, a sentence of 3 for action, punctuating direct speech, story openers and fronted adverbials.

Spelling

We are focusing on Unit 10 of International Phonics which covers the sounds-

/u/ -o, /oo/ -ew, /oo/ -ui, /oo/ -ou, /oo/ -o, /yoo/ -eu, /y+oo/ -ew, /y+oo/ -iew

Health and Wellbeing

We will have Frances every Wednesday delivering yoga and art therapy classes to the children.

The P6 & 7's will also be involved in Positive Psychology sessions on a Monday.

There will be various opportunities for the children to take part in a variety of sporting events throughout the term.

Numeracy & Maths

This term we will be covering multiplication and division. We will be setting challenges for the children to learn all the times tables and they frequently use TT Rockstars to help them with times tables recall. The children will also be learning about decimals, fractions and
