
This will take the approach of Block Play, Outdoor Learning and Play Based Learning.

### **Community-based** Learning




#### Aug/Sep 24'

## Numeracy

## Enquiry-based Learning



- Set up the Outdoor Classroom and begin to use in collaboration with Polytunnel and loose parts play resources.
   Share information with stakeholders to develop wider
  - understanding of approaches.
  - Develop meta-skills framework.
- Visit other schools and work with South Ayrshire Learns team to develop staff understanding of **Play-based** learning and enhance provision.
- Make use of **Block-play** resources across schools and EYC through team-teach approaches and working with lead staff from Straiton Primary.
