#### Numeracy & Maths

During Term 2 we are planning to cover:

- Number Processes
- Time/Calendars
- Symmetry

We will use a variety of active and written tasks to help embed the taught skills.

#### Literacy



**Reading** – In class we will be reading 'Winnie the Pooh' as our class novel. Through this book we will discuss Character, Setting, Main Events and Questions. We will continue to read our banded reading books and apply our understanding of the text through follow up activities in groups, pairs and individually.

**Phonics** – We will continue to follow new sounds for each stage every week. Spelling will consist of active and written tasks and common words will be tested at the end of the week.

**Writing** – Our writing days will be on a Wednesday and we are very lucky to have both teachers in for this. We will begin a new Talk for Writing unit which the children will learn to internalise using actions.

## Interdisciplinary Learning (Topic)

This term we are starting off with a science topic; Plants and Ecosystems.

After that we will learn about the Jewish festival of Hanukah.

Finally, to round off Term 2 we will be getting into the Christmas spirit by reading The Snowman!
