Literacy

Reading – Primary 3 will be reading 'Roddy Doyle Rover Saves Christmas' as their class topic. Pupils will continue to work on reading books and exploring short novels. We will focus on developing decoding skills, fluency and comprehension.

Phonics/Spelling – Primary 3 will be working through our Struthers Primary School Phonics and Spelling Programme. Pupils will continue to explore the different spelling rules and work on commonly used words.

Writing – We will be looking at a variety of writing types through our various topics, particularly focusing on Halloween, Bonfire Night and Christmas.

Numeracy & Maths

During Term 2 we are planning to cover:

- Multiplication and Division
- Time
- Symmetry

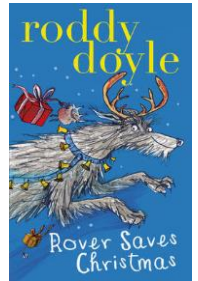
Throughout daily mental maths sessions we will focus on the 4 operations, improving speed and accuracy. We use a combination of Big Maths, Number Talks and Maths Mastery approaches to deliver mental maths lessons. For further challenge, pupils will explore more problem-solving based tasks.

Interdisciplinary Learning

This term we are starting off with the science topic of Plants and Eco-Systems. We will be taking part in a number of lessons outdoors.

We will then be learning all about the Jewish celebration of Hanukkah.

Finally, by revisiting the story of Christmas, we will be learning all about Christmas around the World through our book study – Roddy Doyle Rover Saves Christmas.



Health and Wellbeing

Health and Wellbeing – Pupils will continue to work on a variety of aspects of Health and Wellbeing throughout the Term. We will be focusing on learning about how to keep our bodies and minds healthy, and building positive relationships.
