Literacy



Reading - Through our class novels, we will focus on comprehension skills. We will ask and answer literal, inferential and evaluative questions. Pupils will be collaborating in small groups.

Spelling - Pupils will continue to explore different spelling rules and work on commonly used words.

Writing - We will start the term writing poetry and dramatic scenes. We will also learn about informative writing. Our Talk for Writing block will end the term with imaginative writing.
