Learning at Home

Health and Wellbeing

IDL

In term three, pupils will be exploring World War One as their history focus. This topic will form the basis of lots of exciting lessons across the full curriculum. Our novel study will work alongside our history topic to form interdisciplinary lessons.

Prior to this, throughout January the whole school are exploring Scots Language with each class practising a Scots poem.

Pupils will also have opportunities to engage in outdoor learning in all curricular areas.

Term 3



Literacy

Reading – Primary 5 will be reading 'Five Children on the Western Front' as their whole class text. Pupils will be given opportunities to work on active comprehension and written tasks to develop their questioning and gain a deeper understanding of texts. The comprehension focus of this term is on non-fiction texts which will include texts on our WW1 topic as well as other non-fiction pieces. Pupils will also enjoy 20 minutes of ERIC time every afternoon.

Spelling – On a Monday morning pupils will be given spelling words to practise each day in class which will then be assessed on a Friday through our spelling challenge.

Writing – Pupils will be supported and encouraged to develop their writing skills by getting the opportunity to write in a range of genres. We will continue to focus on planning, structuring ideas, and extending vocabulary and grammar. Pupils will be encouraged to up-level their sentences by applying taught learning from grammar lessons into writing pieces.

Numeracy and Maths

During term three we will be covering:

- Multiplication and Division
- Fractions, Decimals and Percentages
- Measurement – weight, perimeter and area.
- Angles and Coordinates
- Time

Pupils will have access to concrete materials to support active learning in numeracy and maths.
