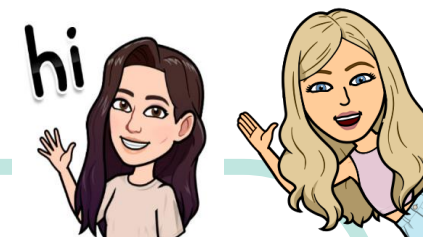




Primary 7.6 Curriculum Flyer

Numeracy and Maths

During term one we will be covering:

- Data Handling
- Addition and Subtraction
- Multiplication and Division

Pupils will have access to concrete materials to support active learning in numeracy and maths.

Homework is completed within the homework jotters and will be gathered in every 3rd Friday.

Health and Wellbeing

Opportunities for Personal Achievement

Pupils will work on self-evaluation within the classroom and will be working towards achieving their SMART targets which will be reviewed and created weekly.

Literacy

Reading – Primary 7.6 will be reading 'The Boy at the Back of the Class' as their whole class text alongside 'The Breadwinner'. Pupils will be given opportunities to work on active comprehension and written tasks to develop their questioning and gain a deeper understanding of texts. Pupils will also enjoy 20 minutes ERIC time every afternoon.

Spelling – On a Monday morning, pupils will be presented with the focus spelling rule/common words for the week and will do activities based on the associated words daily. Spelling words are practised for one week before changing. Pupils will be assessed on these words during our Friday Spelling Challenge.

Writing – As a whole school we are continuing to carry out 'Talk for Writing' blocks each term as well as writing a range of genres often linked to our class topics. We will continue to focus on planning, structuring ideas, and extending vocabulary and grammar. Pupils are encouraged to put maximum effort into their writing presentation and may earn a Bronze, Silver, Gold or Platinum pen license.

Interdisciplinary Learning

In term one we will be exploring 'Road Safety' as our class topic.

We will also use our novel studies to form lessons across the whole curriculum as well as having a focus on Health and Wellbeing as we return to school.

Pupils will also have opportunities to engage in outdoor learning in all curricular areas.

We will explore the UNCRC weekly, in line with our school being a Rights Respecting School.
