Pupils will work on self-evaluation within the classroom and will be working towards achieving their SMART targets which will be reviewed and created each week.


Our Primary 7 pupils are encouraged to take on additional roles and responsibilities and will partake in a variety of exciting transition activities this year.

Spelling – Spelling words are set on a Monday and pupils are given opportunities to work on these each day in class. Pupils are strongly encouraged to practise their spelling words as often as possible at home in preparation for our Friday spelling challenge.

Writing - In Primary 7, we will begin with a focussed 'Talk for Writing' block. Our focus for this term will be a portal story, where each child will be able to form a personal toolkit to work towards their writing goals and aspirations. We will continue to focus on planning, structuring ideas, enriching vocabulary and extending grammar skills. Pupils are encouraged to put maximum effort into their writing presentation and may earn a Bronze, Silver, Gold or Platinum Pen License.

Interdisciplinary Learning

In Term 1 we will be exploring 'Road Safety' as our class topic.

We will also use our novel studies to form lessons across the whole curriculum as well as having a focus on Health and Wellbeing as we return to school.

Pupils will also have opportunities to engage in outdoor learning in all curricular areas.
