Numeracy and Maths

During term two we will be covering:

- Fractions/Decimals/ Percentages
- Number Patterns
- Symmetry and Shape

Pupils will have access to concrete materials to support active learning in numeracy and maths. Pupils will engage in a Maths Challenge each Friday to assess mental maths skills.

Learning at Home

As per the Struthers Homework Policy, homework tasks will be issued on teams for P7s or by sheet on a Monday for P6s. Homework should be completed in homework jotters and returned every 3rd Friday to allow for time for feedback.

Health and Wellbeing

P.E days are Monday and Wednesday. PE kits can be left in school for ease of access.

Opportunities for Personal Achievement

Pupils will work on self-evaluation within the classroom and will be working towards achieving their SMART targets which will be reviewed and created weekly.

Our Primary 7 pupils are encouraged to take on additional responsibilities and will take part in lots of fun transition activities this year.

There are many clubs ongoing within the school, either at lunch or after school which pupils can take part in to give them opportunities for personal achievement.

<u>Literacy</u>

Reading — Primary 7.6 will be reading 'Wild Song' and 'A Christmas Carol' throughout term two as part of our whole-class novel work. Pupils will be given opportunities to work on active comprehension and written tasks to develop their questioning and gain a deeper understanding of texts. Pupils will also enjoy 20 minutes ERIC time every afternoon.

Spelling — On a Monday morning, pupils will be presented with the focus spelling rule/common words for the week and will do activities based on the associated words daily. Spelling words are practised for 2 weeks before changing. They will be assessed on these words during our Friday Spelling Challenge.

Writing — Pupils will be focussing on critical writing throughout term two allowing them to explore a variety of different topics and think critically about them. Pupils are encouraged to put maximum effort into their writing presentation and may earn a Bronze, Silver, Gold or Platinum pen license.

Interdisciplinary Learning

In term two we will be exploring 'Space' as our science class topic and in the later half of the term we will explore Sikhism as part of our whole-school Religion focus.

Pupils will also have opportunities to engage in outdoor learning in all curricular areas.

We will explore the UNCRC weekly, in line with our school being a Rights Respecting School.
