Numeracy and Maths

During term four we will be covering:

- Measure
- Position and Movement
- Word Problems
- Consolidation

Learners will have access to concrete materials to support active learning in Numeracy and Maths. Learners will engage in daily mental maths work through our Big Maths CLIC.

Homework consists of Literacy and Numeracy tasks.

Literacy

Reading – Primary 3 will be reading 'The BFG' as their class novel. Additionally, learners will develop reading daily through decodable texts and banded reading books. Through reading we will focus on developing decoding and encoding skills, fluency, and comprehension. Learners will also enjoy 20 minutes of ERIC time every afternoon.

Phonics/Spelling – Primary 3 will continue to work through our Struthers Primary School Phonics Progression alongside South Ayrshire Reads. Learners will explore a phoneme and a set of common words weekly.

Writing – Learners will be working on a Marr Cluster Schools Creative Writing Project this term as well as consolidating all other writing genres including recount, report, persuasive, and poetry writing.

Interdisciplinary Learning

In term four we will be exploring 'Farming' as our Geography topic. As always, our topic will be based on and focussed on the learners' interests and questions.

Later in term four we have a responsive planning block where the topic will be decided in collaboration with the class.

We will relate learning to and explore the UNCRC weekly in line with our school being a Rights Respecting School.
