During Term 4 we are planning to cover:

Health and Wellbeing

Literacy



Reading – In class we will be reading 'The Reluctant Time Traveller' as our class novel. Reading homework will be in the form of novels at home and we encourage children to read for enjoyment for at least 15 minutes every night. Some children will have books in class to support their reading fluency.

Phonics – We will continue to follow South Ayrshire Reads phonics progression. Spelling will consist of active and written tasks and graphemes will be tested at the end of each week.

Writing – Our writing days will be on a **Tuesday** and this term we will focus on creative writing by creating our own books.

Interdisciplinary Learning (Topic)

We will learn about different types of farming in Scotland and for the final few weeks of term we will explore geography through a World Cup topic.

Other Curricular Areas

On Tuesdays & Wednesdays, Mrs Yost will be in class to teach Problem Solving, Music and French. She will also be working with Primary 4s across the year group to support writing.
