Literacy

Reading – Primary 2.3 begin Term 4 by reading 'Flat Stanley' as our class novel. This will enable pupils to begin reading chapter stories independently, read for understanding and answer a wide range of questions. Pupils will continue to develop decoding and fluency skills by reading texts suited to the Primary 2 and Primary 3 stage. Later in the term we will be exploring character and setting by reading Roald Dahl's, 'George's Marvellous Medicine'.

Phonics – Primary 2 and Primary 3 pupils will follow our Struthers Phonics and spelling Programme, alongside South Ayrshire Reads.

Writing – This term we will be exploring a variety of writing types for a range of audiences including instructional, fact-files and imaginative pieces. Towards the end of Term 4 we will take part in the whole school 'Creative Writing Project', allowing pupils to create, share and celebrate a short story of their own.

Interdisciplinary Learning

At the start of Term 4, our learning will focus on the theme of Farming. We will explore different types of farming, learn about the role of a farmer, and understand why this job is so important.

Later in the term, pupils will vote on a topic of their choice, giving them the opportunity to decide what they would like to learn about.

We will then round off the term by looking at Summer Safety for the upcoming holiday. This will include being outdoors, sun and water safety.
