Literacy

Reading – P2 will be reading a variety of Farming focussed stories and non-fiction texts. We will then be reading 'George's Marvellous Medicine' as our class novel.

Phonics/Spelling – Primary 2 will continue to be working through our Struthers Primary School Phonics and Spelling Programme, alongside South Ayrshire Reads. Pupils will continue to explore the different spelling rules and work on commonly used words.

Writing – We will be exploring a variety of writing types for a range of audiences including instructional, fact files and imaginative pieces. We will also continue to focus on handwriting.

Grammar – we have a weekly grammar session. Some of our topics include homophones, commas and speech marks.

Health and Wellbeing

P.E. – Our P.E. days are Monday and Thursday. **Please ensure that your child comes prepared for P.E. For safety reasons, it is very important that pupils have suitable shoes to change into. Long hair should also be tied back.**

Mental Health is a constant focus in class, taking part in mindfulness and breathing exercises, as well as regularly talking about feelings and emotions.

Learning @ Home

Homework will consist of Literacy and Numeracy tasks, this term we are also going to do personal talks, with pupils making something to show what they have learned about dinosaurs.

Numeracy & Maths

During Term 4 we are planning to cover:

- Division
- Fractions
- Measuring Length, Weight & Volume
- Problem Solving

Throughout daily mental maths sessions we will focus on the 4 operations, improving speed and accuracy. We use a combination of Big Maths and Number Talks approaches to deliver mental maths lessons.

We will also continue to use Sumdog online.

Interdisciplinary Learning

Primary 2 will be starting off Term 4 with a farming topic. We will look at different types of farming and the job of those involved.

We will then have P2 pupils voting on what they would like to learn about next.

We will round up the term by looking at Summer Safety for the upcoming holiday. This will include bike, water and sun safety.
