

# Primary 3/4 Curriculum Flyer

## Literacy



**Reading** – Primary 3/4 will be reading ‘Planet Omar – Accidental Trouble Magnet’ as their class novel. Pupils will continue to work on reading books and exploring short novels to continue to develop their vocabulary. We will focus on developing decoding and encoding skills, fluency, and comprehension.

**Phonics/Spelling** – Primary 3/4 will continue to be working through our Struthers Primary School Phonics and Spelling Programme, alongside South Ayrshire Reads. Pupils will continue to explore the different spelling rules and work on commonly used words.

**Writing** – This term, we will focus on a few types of writing. At the beginning of term 4, we will focus on recount writing. The class will then do a short block on instructional writing - some of which will be based on our farming topic. Towards the end of the school year, the class will work on creating their own story.

## Health and Wellbeing

**Health and Wellbeing** – Pupils will learn about diversity and discrimination in term 4. They will also have a block on healthy eating with Miss Gibson.

**P.E.** – Our P.E. days are Tuesday and Friday. Pupils will start a new block a chosen sport. They will then move onto some practice for sports day, building on their athletics skills.

Please ensure that your child comes prepared for P.E. Kits can be left in school.

## Learning @ Home

Pupils should complete their homework tasks in their set homework jotter. HW sheets will continue to be printed each week, sheets will focus on the literacy task. Maths tasks will be a mix of Sumdog or a worksheet. Jotters will continue to be collected on a Thursday.

## Numeracy & Maths

During Term 4 we are planning to cover:

- Maps + coordinates
- Position + movement – angles
- Data Handling
- Revision of Multiplication + Division
- Revision of Addition + Subtraction

We will also be continuing Number Talks approaches to deliver mental maths lessons. For further challenge, pupils will explore more problem-solving and word problem-based tasks which focuses on using maths skills in context. Pupils will continue to use manipulatives to help solve more complicated problems.

## Interdisciplinary Learning



For the final term we will focus on a block on farming. Pupils will learn about the different types of farming in our local area. They will learn about the role of farming to create food. The class will also learn about sustainability in farming.

The final topic of the term will focus on the upcoming World Cup. Pupils will learn about different countries competing in the World Cup and learn to locate them on maps. Pupils will complete research on a specific country taking part in the World Cup. This topic will also link into learning about children’s rights.
