Literacy & English

Writing – we will be using The Write Stuff and Kensuke's Kingdom to develop our skills. As well as diary entries, discursive, imaginative and journalistic pieces through our topics as well as functional writing too.

Health & Wellbeing

- We will be looking at emotional wellbeing and body image, alcohol – understanding risks and peer pressure, exploring relationships and human reproduction.
- We will also be developing our athletics skills during P.E. as well as Co-operative games like handball, leadership skills and sportsmanship.

What you can do to help at home:

Spelling	In spelling jotters <ul style="list-style-type: none">write the word 3 more times using LOOK, COVER, WRITE, CHECK.Complete at least 100 points worth of activities from your spelling contract which will include your 5 sentences,
Maths	Usually related to the work being covered in class to reinforce the learning. See Teams for online maths homework. If your child struggles with a particular area e.g. tables, please encourage your child to ask for help and I can issue additional resources.
Other	Occasionally there may be a research task which will be longer than the standard homework. Your child will receive notice of this and the submission date for their diary.
