

Numeracy & Maths

We will be learning:

- Number - numbers to 20 and beyond
 - to subtract and link addition and subtraction facts (fact families)
- Time - recognise, show and write o'clock on analogue and digital clocks. Name and order days of the week and months of the year.
- Measure - estimate, compare and measure length, weight and volume using non-standard units.
- Data Analysis - to understand and create various types of graphs.

Health & Wellbeing

We will be learning about:

- making and keeping friendships.
- different jobs people do.
- identifying who to go to when we need help.
- medicine safety, knowing what is safe and unsafe to eat.
- what babies need.
- hygiene, washing hands and brushing teeth.

Literacy

- In Reading we will be continuing to read Dandelion Readers decodable stories and learn some new tricky code (common words)
- We will continue to work on writing simple sentences.
- In Active literacy we will learn digraphs (2 letter sounds). We will try to use these words in our writing.
- We will look at character traits and create our own characters.
