
VOLUNTEER POLICY (including Parent Helpers)

<u>Rationale</u>: We are regularly asked by members of our school community if we would like their assistance. We greatly value this support however, we must ensure our volunteers know what is expected of them. In addition to this we must remember our duty to ensure the safety and privacy of our pupils.

AIMS OF THIS POLICY

- To outline the procedures required prior to any volunteer being started in school
- To outline the responsibilities of all those involved
- To indicate the type of tasks volunteers may be requested to complete

RESPONSIBILITIES

Senior Management Team

- agree to a volunteer placement once having spoken to the volunteer and shared our volunteering policy
- notify the staff member who will be working alongside the volunteer
- monitoring the success of the volunteers input and reporting back to the volunteer Volunteer Mentor
- complete induction form with volunteer (see appendix 1)

All Other Staff

• To welcome our volunteer and support our volunteer

Pupils

• To welcome our volunteer and display the same behaviour that is acceptable for all other adults in school

Volunteer

- adhere to the agreed times of arrival and departure
- follow the guidance given by staff members
- report any concerns to the volunteer mentor

SUGGESTED VOLUNTEER ACTIVITIES

- playground supervision
- shredding
- assisting on a school outing
- assisting during craft activities
- tidying/organising
- sharing a skill
