#### LITERACY

This term, there will be a focus on reading stories of children's choice and exploring the events and characters within the text. Children will learn to share their thoughts and feelings about the book in different ways. We will discuss the different features of books such as the blurb, author, illustrator, and spine. We will be using different materials and resources to mark, make and write through play experiences both indoors and outdoors, with a focus on the children's interests. Listening and talking – where they can talk about their interests and themselves as well as listen to others.

#### NUMERACY & MATHS

This term, we are focusing on measure and developing a sense of size and amount. Children will observe, explore, and communicate with peers through play-based activities to compare sizes, weight, length and amounts of everyday items in their environment. We will be learning to explore and recognise patterns, developing the skill to copy and continue these as well as creating our own. We will be learning to collect, match, count and sort different objects through play. Our starting point for Number is recognising where we see dots, groups, sets & numerals and how we count & use them in our day.

#### HEALTH AND WELLBEING

This term is all about settling in and finding out about one another. Children will develop the ability to express their feelings and thoughts and talk about them with their peers. Children will focus on developing friendships, working in groups, and sharing with others, as well as understanding new routines as part of the EYC. We will be developing our physical movement skills and our ability to use and share space through indoor and outdoor play. Children will learn about good hygiene and implement this as part of their daily routine within the EYC. We will continue to recognise our own rights and practice respecting the rights of others.

#### OTHER CLASS INFORMATION

We welcome our new starts & returners to the new term of Nursery. Initially, our focus will be on settling into nursery and learning about rules and routines. Children will participate daily in singing our 'Days of the Week' song and will begin to understand what days come before and after. We will learn through play-based experiences, making great use of our outdoor space. We will also be learning basic everyday communication through Makaton, such as 'good morning' and 'good afternoon'. Settling in is the first priority and learners will be finding out about one another and their new environment.
