## CURRICULAR MAP – TERM 1



### PRIMARY 3

Class Teachers: Mrs McCracken & Mrs Wyper

#### LITERACY

- **Spelling** - Jolly Grammar weekly spelling.
- **Grammar** – alphabetical order, sentence writing, speech marks, questions, commas in lists, exclamation marks.
- **Personal Writing** – Focus on using capital letters and punctuation in writing tasks accurately.
- **Listening and Talking** - Pupils will regularly use First News and Newsround as a stimulus for class and small group discussions.
- **Reading** - characters, setting, word recognition, fluency, pace, oral and written comprehension.

#### NUMERACY & MATHS

- **Numeracy** - Addition of tens and units with and without carrying.
- **Subtraction** – Subtraction of tens and units with and without exchanging.
- **Daily Mental Maths** - Number Talks using Blueprint Boards, developing addition strategies, strategies to tackle worded problems and problem solving.
- **Measure** – Explore length using centimetres and metres.

#### SOCIAL STUDIES

##### The Farm

This term our topic is Farming and Food. Pupils will investigate farming within the local environment and explore the variety of foods produced here in Troon and nationally throughout Scotland. Through science activities, pupils will identify conditions needed for successful farming and will be given the opportunity to apply this knowledge to grow their own plants within the classroom. During class and personal research tasks, pupils will discuss the job of a farmer and other roles within food production, where food comes from and consolidate their understanding of a healthy balanced diet.

Primary 3 look forward to visiting a working farm at Dumfries House on Tuesday 26 September.

#### OTHER CLASS INFORMATION

- **P.E.** - Outside PE, learning and play across the week.
- **Library** - Weekly visits to school library. Books will be stored in children's trays and enjoyed throughout the week in class.
- **ICT** - Weekly visit to ICT suite with focus on logging on and developing word processing skills.
- **Music** - Learning to choose different musical instruments to play such as chime bar, tambourine, triangle or body percussion, exploring sound and rhythm.
- Learning to perform short patterns using pictures or symbols.
