## LITERACY

**Spelling** - A sound will be taught each week with an initial sound and Tricky Words. These will be listed in our Literacy Homework jotter to learn at home. Throughout the week the children will be given opportunities to learn these using a range of active spelling activities.

**Reading** - The stories in Story World and Bug Club will be read throughout the term. Characters and events in the story will be discussed with comprehension activities in class. We will be working hard on reading with fluency and expression as well as discussing our favourite characters.

**Writing** - Personal Writing – My Summer, 10 Things About Me, What Makes Me Happy, A Recipe for Friendship, A Friendly Letter from Me.

<u>Listening and Talking</u> - Interesting Things About Me. Hobbies Presentation.

## **NUMERACY & MATHS**

<u>Mental Maths</u> - strategies to use for quick recall of number bonds, word problems and class Number Talks (discussion of strategies used and how to make a number).

<u>Numeracy Blueprint Boards</u> - using 10 frames, 100 number square, number lines. <u>Addition and Subtraction within 20</u> - quick recall of number bonds, finding the link between addition and subtraction, finding the missing number and using words for addition and subtraction, e.g. sum of, find the difference etc.

<u>Numbers to 100</u> - counting to 100, finding the number before, after, between, 2 more, 2 less etc and writing numbers in words.

### **SOCIAL STUDIES**

### Our topic this term is minibeasts

- Living and non-living things.
- Sorting living things into groups vertebrates and invertebrates.
- Knowing where living things come from, how they grow and develop.
- Establishing and exploring the 6 minibeast groupings: insects, molluscs, annelids, myriapods, arachnids and crustaceans.
- Minibeast Care Human destruction of natural habitats and the effects this has on the wildlife living there. Ways we can protect the environment.
