LITERACY

- Jolly Grammar weekly spelling.

NUMERACY & MATHS

- Daily Mental Maths - Number Talks using Blueprint Boards, developing addition and subtraction strategies to tackle worded problems and problem solving.

SOCIAL STUDIES

- Living and non-living things.
- Sorting living things into groups - vertebrates and invertebrates.
- Knowing where living things come from, how they grow and develop.
- Establishing and exploring the 6 minibeast groupings: insects, molluscs, annelids, myriapods, arachnids and crustaceans.
