LITERACY

This term the children will continue to develop their literacy skills through South Ayrshire Reads (SAR). Pupils will build confidence and accuracy in reading and spelling through focuses on phonemes, graphemes and morphology.

We have started our novel, 'The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas', which links to our first topic World War II. We will use this novel to build on our Critical Literacy skills in preparation for secondary school.

Our reading and writing experiences this term will link closely with our World War II topic. Children will explore a variety of texts and sources, using them to develop critical thinking and discussion skills. Writing opportunities will include imaginative stories, diary entries, letters and other genres inspired by the experiences of wartime children.

SOCIAL STUDIES

This term, our interdisciplinary topic will be World War II, a subject that has already sparked great interest and enthusiasm among the children. Through this topic, pupils will explore how historical events continue to shape the world we live in today, while making meaningful links to current events and developing an understanding of the importance of history in our society.

There will be opportunities for children to share aspects of their own family history and personal connections to the past. To further enrich their learning, children will also be invited use the homework grid provided, allowing them to explore an area of interest related to the topic and share their learning with others.

NUMERACY & MATHS

This term, we have started looking at our mental recall and the four operations. We will continue to focus on mental maths and rapid recall of times tables throughout Primary 7.

Our first steps in maths will be to concentrate on consolidating and building on previous learning and looking at Place Value and Whole Number.

We will move on to looking at BODMAS and shape.

OTHER CLASS INFORMATION

Primary 7 is one of the busiest times for pupils. We will be looking at appointing our new House Captains.

We will be working with Active Schools in the coming weeks to complete the Junior Coaching Award. We will also be working with Vince for Volleyball.
