Staffing Update

We welcome Miss Denise Fairbairn to school. Miss Fairbairn joins us as our visiting PE specialist. Miss Fairbairn will work with each class on a Tuesday.

We would also like to welcome Miss Samantha Brennan to our team. Miss Brennan joins us as an Additional Needs Assistant.

We have two new members of staff in our ELC. Miss Emily Anderson joins us as an Early Years Practitioner and Miss Mya Lamb as an Early Years Modern Apprentice.

This session we are delighted that Miss Kirsty Scott will also be with us as our Nurture Teacher. Miss Scott will be working across the school on a Friday.

PE Day

As intimated above, please note that all children in P1-P7 will have their PE day on a **Tuesday**. A reminder that for PE, children are required to have a plain white t-shirt, plain black or navy shorts and trainers. Children may also wear black leggings or plain black/navy tracksuit bottoms. On PE days children must still come to school in their school jumper or sweatshirt. Football tops and non-school hoodies/tops are not acceptable at any time. Sportswear should not be worn on non PE days. Jewellery is a safety hazard and should not be worn to school.

New Bell

Following consultation with the children and staff we are trialling a new bell system this session. We have changed the sound from a standard bell to a more melodic sound. In addition, the bell has been reset to include a two minute warning prior to the end of break and lunch to allow children to gather themselves and begin to think about transition back into class.

Tyres in the Playground

We have had more new tyres installed in the playground and the remaining trim track has been repaired. We have a few loose tyres left over which the children have delighted in playing with at break time. We are hoping to increase our use and variety of loose parts for outdoor breaks and learning across the session.

Flu Immunisation

Your child will bring home a form for their flu immunisation which is due to take place in school on 14th November. Please fill this in and return it to the school office.
