Pupil Safety - School Gates

If you are collecting your child we ask that you park outside the school gates unless you have made a prior arrangement with the school.

Building Resilience - Look on the Bright Side Family Learning

A reminder that your child's Look on the Bright Side family learning should be shared with the school by next Friday. Families were asked to create a memory jar together which includes items that are special to you all. It is hoped that your jar will help your gratitude for the good things in your life and share memories of good things. The following week examples of this family learning will be shared during assembly.

Showbie

At our recent Meet the Teacher evening some parents shared feedback on how they were accessing their child's portfolio. This included seeing some 'empty' folders or assignments. While Showbie is used as a method of reporting to you on your child's progress, it is also used as a tool to support and enhance learning, teaching and assessment across the week. Therefore at times you may see Assignments which are empty, as teachers have created these to upload resources for the following week as part of their ongoing planning.

All pieces of learning which have been commented on by the teacher will go into your child's Portfolio so you can quickly access this feedback without having to look through the folders.

You can control the notifications you receive from Showbie in your parental account settings, by clicking on Preferences. This allows you to select which notifications you wish to receive that suit your preferences and needs.

Parent Volunteers

The school will be welcoming members of the Showbie team on the afternoon of **Monday 25th September** to hear about the ways in which we are using Showbie to support learning and how this is shared with you as parents. If you would like to be part of a small focus group we would be delighted to hear from you. This short chat would take place just before the end of the school/ELC day at **2.45pm**.
