Head Teacher's Update

Dear all,

In school this week, the children have had more opportunities to engage in outdoor learning. Lisa from GoWild returned again for sessions involving three of our classes, our ELC pupils were given opportunities to develop their understanding of Road Safety by going on short tours of the outdoor areas around the school, and our P1/2 class also enjoyed a mini rugby tots session outdoors.

Our P7 pupils attended the Remembrance Assembly at Gala Academy this morning and all were exemplary in their respectful listening. We are so grateful to Clare Swan from School's Out who supported the children to attend by providing and driving her minibus to and from the Academy. We would continue to urge you to support our partnership with School's Out and think about booking your child in for a session either before or after school.

Other opportunities that have been offered to the children have included the BBC Teach 500 Words story writing competition. There has been lots of creativity from the children who have chosen to engage in this.

We have also been working with the children in our weekly gatherings to promote their understanding of being Included – one of our school aims. We have now explored all of our school aims, which are based on the Wellbeing Indicators of Safe, Healthy, Achieving, Nurtured, Active, Respected, Responsible and Included. The children have created their own statement on each of these. They are being used to support all children's health and wellbeing and to continue to promote our school values, vision and the importance of a positive and happy ethos in our school.

Across the school, all the children are engaged in creating artwork for our Kindness Calendar and working in partnership with the Parent Council to create and publish this. The designs are wonderful and I am sure many families will enjoy using the calendar next year.

Behind the scenes preparation is underway for all the Christmas activities and events that are planned and the first of those will be the Christmas Fair. Please see the Parent Council update below for ways in which you can be part of this important fundraiser and support your child's school.

A reminder that next week the children will be receiving their flu immunisations. We will also be launching our next Building Resilience Unit whereby we will be asking you to again engage in the family learning task which will support your child to develop their health and wellbeing, resilience and understanding of the tools that enhance emotional regulation.

School Enrolment Week 20th - 24th November 2023

Primary School Enrolment

If your child is five years of age before the end of February 2025, they are eligible to attend primary school from August 2024. Please visit **www.scotborders.gov.uk/schoolenrolment** during or after enrolment week and upload a copy of your child's birth certificate and proof of your address.

Secondary School Enrolment

If your child is moving from primary to secondary school in August 2024 you will receive details of the local catchment school from their current primary school.

Placement requests If you want to send your child to a school that is out with your catchment area this is called a placement request. If you choose to make a placement request you must also make contact with your catchment school and complete an on-line enrolment form so that they can reserve a place for your child in the event that your placement request is refused. You should then contact your preferred school and complete an on-line placement request form. To find out more you can visit us online www.scotborders.gov.uk/schoolenrolment

Early Learning and Childcare (ELC) Enrolments – 3 & 4 year olds

Children born between 1st March 2020 and 28 February 2022 will be eligible for up to 1140 hours of funded ELC from August 2024, these hours are allocated on a pro-rata basis depending on when children start throughout the year. Funded ELC is free to families and is paid for by the Scottish Government and local authorities. It can be provided at school nurseries, private and voluntary managed nurseries and playgroups and some childminders who have a contract with Scottish Borders Council to provide funded places. Parents are asked to make contact

with the ELC setting of their choice to discuss options for their child prior to making an application during enrolment week. Further information www.scotborders.gov.uk/elc

Deferred Entry Applications

New legislation means that children who turn 5 years of age between 15th August 2024 and 28th February 2025 are able to defer their entry to P1 and receive another year of funded ELC Further information www.scotborders.gov.uk/elc


