Dear all,

It was great to see almost all of you in school this week attending your child's Pupil Progress Consultation and visiting your child's classroom to look at samples of their learning. This week the children have been starting to create their crafts to sell at our upcoming Christmas Fair. There will be lots of fabulous items for sale and we do hope you are able to join us on Friday 1st December from 11.45am.

Ticket prices are just £1.00 for each Dress Rehearsal, the ELC Christmas Show is £2.00 per ticket and the Nativity and Concert Evening Performances are £2.50 per ticket.

Congratulations to the following Star Achievers for showing our school values in action, for using their learning powers effectively to support their progress, and for showing their developing understanding of our school aims:




