Dear all,

Some great outdoor learning has taken place this week for our P3/4 class who were at Old Melrose on a class trip supported by TweedWATCH. The children took part in workshops that were linked to their interdisciplinary learning in school.

Our P7 children took part in a Developing the Young Workforce event at the Academy as part of their ongoing transition and the feedback from the children was positive; "It was really good!"




Contributions Assembly


