Achievements Assembly

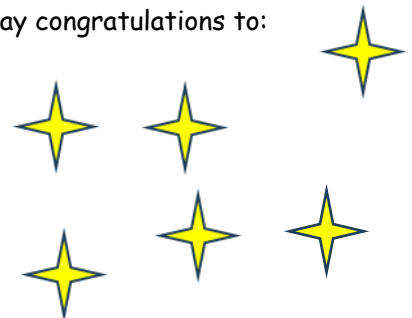
