

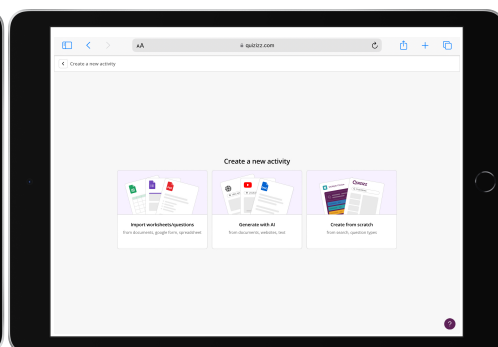
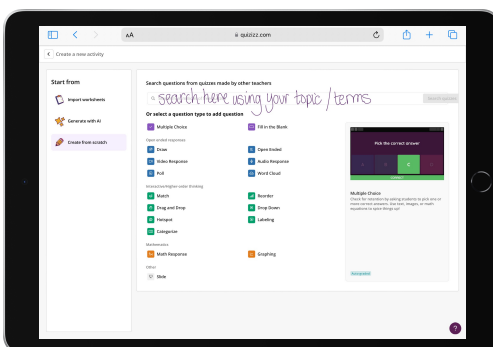
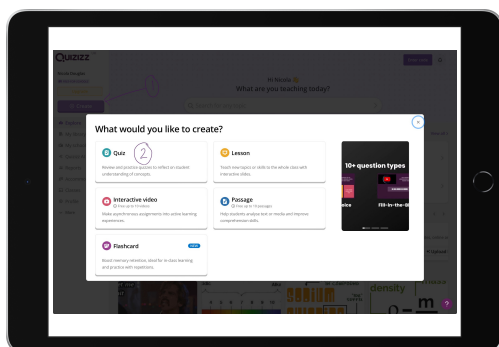


A Quick Guide to: Quizizz



Go to quizizz.com and sign up. If there are more than 5 teachers in your school when you sign up you will get access to “free-for-schools” features!

- To get started, select the purple “+ Create” on the left hand side of your screen.
- There are different options to try, we will look at the Quiz feature - select that
- You can import questions in another format, generate using AI and a document such as SQA spec or create from scratch
- Selecting create from scratch allows you to search the community for questions on your topic or write your own questions

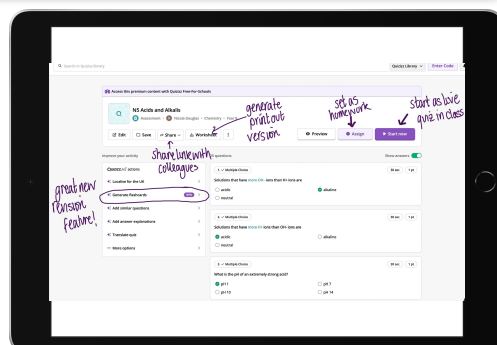
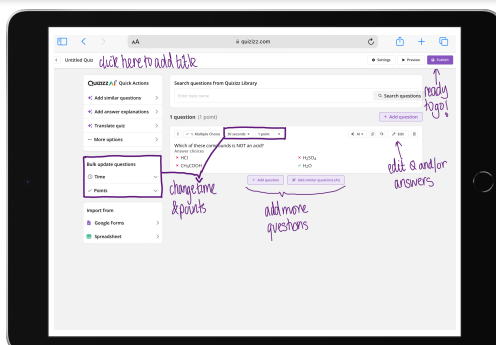
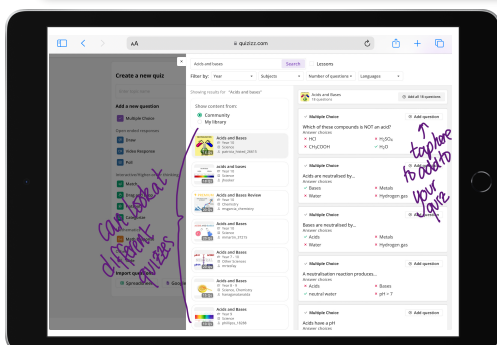


Once you search, you can look at the different quizzes already made and select questions to add to your quiz. You can select questions from different quizzes. *Don't worry if it is not quite correct, you can edit after.* Once you have finished selecting questions, press the cross to return to your quiz.

In your quiz, you can:

- change the settings for time and points by question or in bulk
- edit questions / answers
- Add other questions, from community, making your own or using AI
- Translate
- Title your quiz
- Publish your quiz for use

After your quiz is published and you are ready to use, select it from your list. You then get LOADS of options: share with colleagues, set as homework, use as live quiz, generate flashcards and make further edits



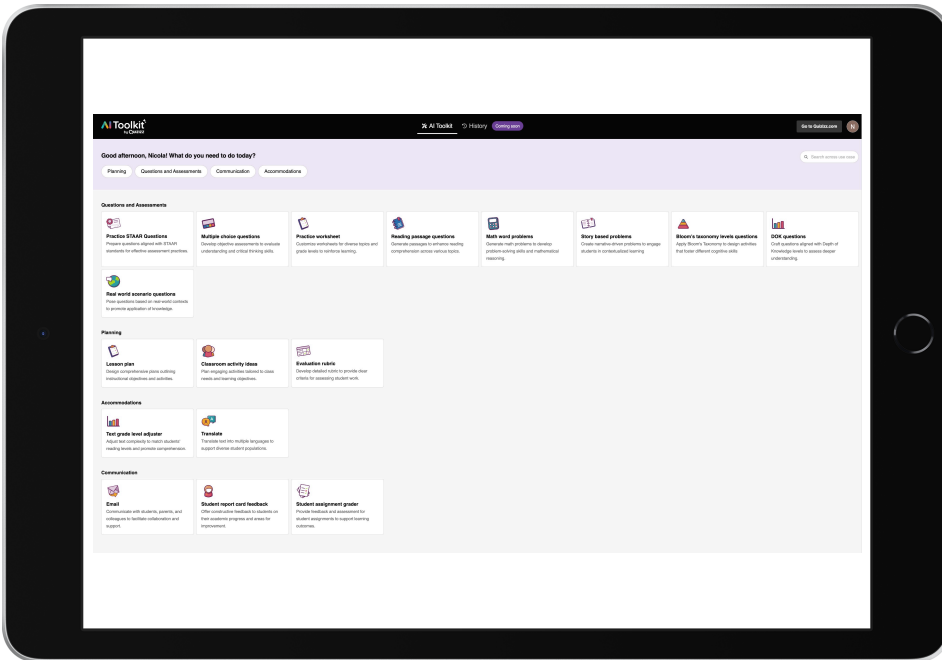
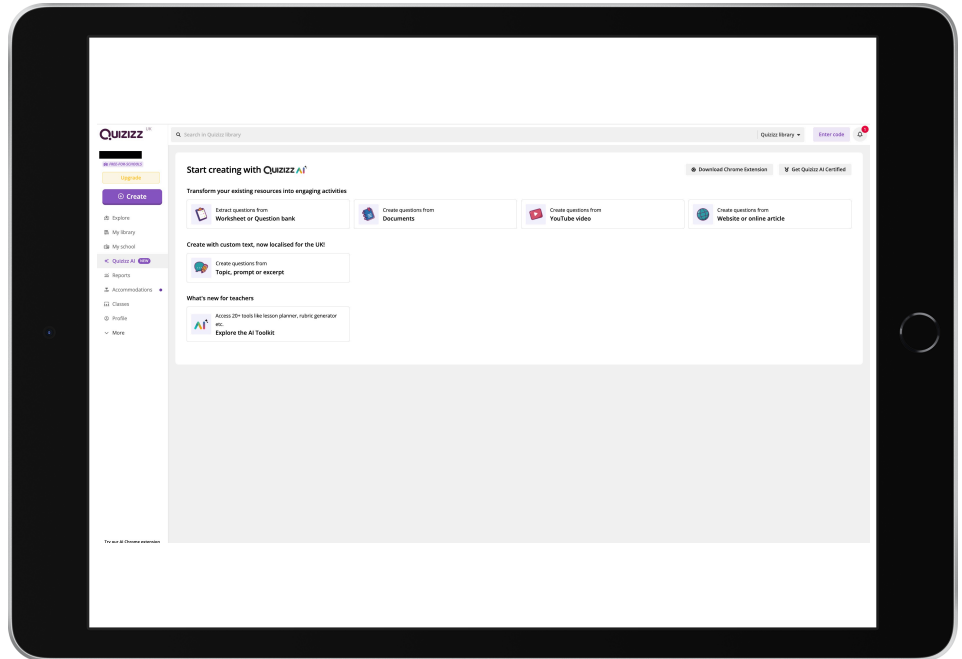


A Quick Guide to: Quizizz AI



Create Quiz with AI

- Select either “+ Create” or “Quizizz AI” on the left hand side menu
- You can upload a worksheet, a document, video link or website link. You can even create from a prompt - a simple topic title will do but more information will give better questions.
- If you have a Quizizz already, you can add extra questions using AI by going into ‘edit’
- You can use the questions as they are or edit



AI Toolkit

The toolkit provides more AI options than on create Quizizz.

- There are more tools for questions including generating a reading passage and accompanying questions and providing real world scenarios for questions
- Planning aids includes generating lesson plans and activities from prompts (again the more detail the better)
- Accommodations such as translate (others also available in ‘normal’ create and use quizizz such as read aloud and extra time)
- Communication tools to support
