<b>Teachers</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Teachers are members of the SchoolHouse Team on Teams</li> <li>Showbie is being used as per school policy</li> <li>Teams / One Note is being used as school policy</li> <li>Teachers have an awareness of Cyber Resilience and Internet Safety</li> <li>Teachers are able to request a website to be blocked</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Teachers can trouble shoot common problems – hard reset and proxy etc. They know when and where to access support – CGI</li> <li>Teachers engage with Inspire Learning content – School House CPD sessions, Inspire website etc</li> <li>Teachers have Apple Teacher accreditation</li> <li>Teachers are aware of Everyone Can Create resource</li> </ul>
<b>Ethos</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pupils and staff take responsibility for keeping their iPad charged, software up to date and in good working order</li> <li>Pupils take appropriate care of iPad and hardware</li> <li>Cyber Resilience and Internet Safety is planned for</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pupils can trouble shoot common problems – hard reset and proxy etc. They know where to access support in school</li> </ul>
<b>Apple Classroom/ Apple TV</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All pupils added to class(es) in Apple Classroom</li> <li>Teacher can use Apple Classroom as a class management tool</li> <li>Apple TV is used to share teacher's iPad screen to share resources/ instruction/pupil work</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Teacher can use Apple Classroom in a variety of ways e.g for formative assessment/feedback/differentiation/sharing student screens</li> </ul>
<b>Digital Assessment Tools</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A variety of tools such as Socrative, Forms, Showbie, Quizizz, Kahoot can be used for formative assessment</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Departments have shared spaces and resources to collaborate on and share assessments</li> </ul>
<b>Showbie/Teams/OneNote</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Staff use Showbie/Teams/OneNote to set and differentiate learning where appropriate</li> <li>Pupils can access work and upload work independently to the appropriate folder</li> <li>Pupils can use various tools to show their learning such as voice note, dictation, text comment etc</li> <li>Staff can use Showbie/Teams/OneNote to give feedback (in line with school policy)</li> <li>Showbie is used for reporting to parents in line with school policy</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Parent groups are established and used in line with school policy</li> <li>Socrative is linked to Showbie</li> </ul>
<b>Accessibility Tools</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Teacher is aware of key accessibility features needed by their learners</li> <li>Core personalisation/accessibility features that support learning are used by pupils where appropriate: Spoken Content, Dictation, Colour Filters, Immersive Reader</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Learners have the choice of apps/tools to complete an assignment when appropriate</li> <li>Learners have opportunities to use technology for their learning outside the classroom</li> <li>Learners have opportunities to collaborate on documents/ projects</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Learners are given opportunities to develop digital skills needed for education, business and communities. E.g using email, presenting information and yourself on screen, experiencing video conferencing.</li> </ul>
